WILL MY PET GET WET?

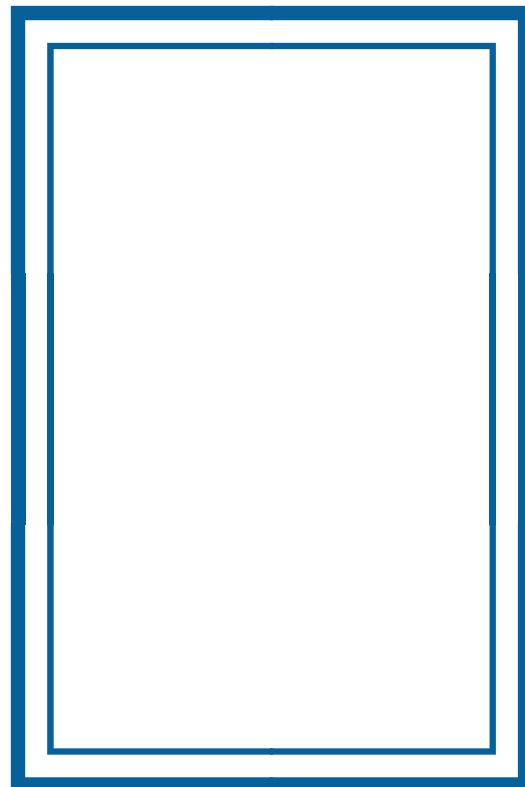
