YOU'LL NEED:

- 1 shoe box
 - 2 smaller boxes that can fit inside the shoe box
 - 1 bottle of apple juice or pee-colored juice
(remove the label for elephant pee)
 - 2 smaller items inside the shoe box
(e.g. bag of chips and a puzzle)
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HOW TO USE:

- 1 Place the following page on top of the shoe box.
- 2 Place the second page on the second smaller box (adjust paper to box size). For the *What should you like to find in this box?* section, fill in your own answer (e.g. bag of chips).
- 3 Place the third page on the third smaller box (adjust paper to box size). For the *What should and would you like to find in this box?* section, fill in your own answer (e.g. a puzzle).
- 4 Place the final two pages on the bottle of juice.
- 5 To play, allow your student to choose what box they want to open in whatever order.
