#### 1 shoe box

- 2 smaller boxes that can fit inside the shoe box

## **HOW TO USE:**

- 1 Place the following page on top of the shoe box.
- 2 Place the second page on the second smaller box (adjust paper to box size). For the What should you like to find in this box? section, fill in your own answer (e.g. bag of chips).
- 3 Place the third page on the third smaller box (adjust paper to box size). For the What should and would you like to find in this box? section, fill in your own answer (e.g. a puzzle).
  - 4 Place the final two pages on the bottle of juice. 5 To play, allow your student to choose what box
    - they want to open in whatever order.
